Since its inception in 2005, the A+ Education Foundation has awarded over \$757,000 to over 822 grant recipients in schools and districts across Central Texas.

Professionally-Certified Educators (grades Pre-K through 12) in the schools in the A+ Federal Credit Union’s field of membership may apply. The A+ Education Foundation Board selects members of the educational community to review applications. Grant winners will be notified July 18, 2018.
