Grant applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, May 31, 2020. Professionally-Certified Educators (grades Pre-K through 12) in the schools in the A+ Federal Credit Union’s field of membership may apply. Grant winners will be notified July 15, 2020.
